



Patient-Learning-Center

The Learning Center is an important new health information resource in the German area. The Patient-Learning-Center gives patients, visitors, and members of the community the opportunity to learn more about health and illness and take a more active role in their own health care. Three components are available to serve your needs.

The Health Information Library

An extensive collection of books, periodicals, videos, and computer software on a wide variety of health care topics, including cancer. Internet access is also available, so you can access the Cancer Center website from here. **The library is open to the general public.**

Health Education for Living Programm

A number of services are available to help patients and families better understand and participate in their treatment for cancer, as well as other conditions. Services include a learning lab where a nurse can teach a referred patient or family member a needed health care skill, such as how to give injection, or how to help someone who is sick at home. They also help clinicians in their ongoing encounters with patients by providing materials development and support so that high quality educational materials are on hand in the clinical areas.

Partnerships for Health

The Patient-Learning-Center offers a broad array of programs and services targeted toward identified health education needs in specific populations. These include: seminars series on health topics given either at The Learning Center or in community settings, community outreach initiatives designed to promote health, and partnership work with community health centers on identified health education needs.

The Patient-Learning-Center is located on the lobby of the Krankenhaus der Barmherzigen Brüder Trier.

It is open Monday-Friday from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. – 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. Also it is open at the first Saturday in the month from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.
